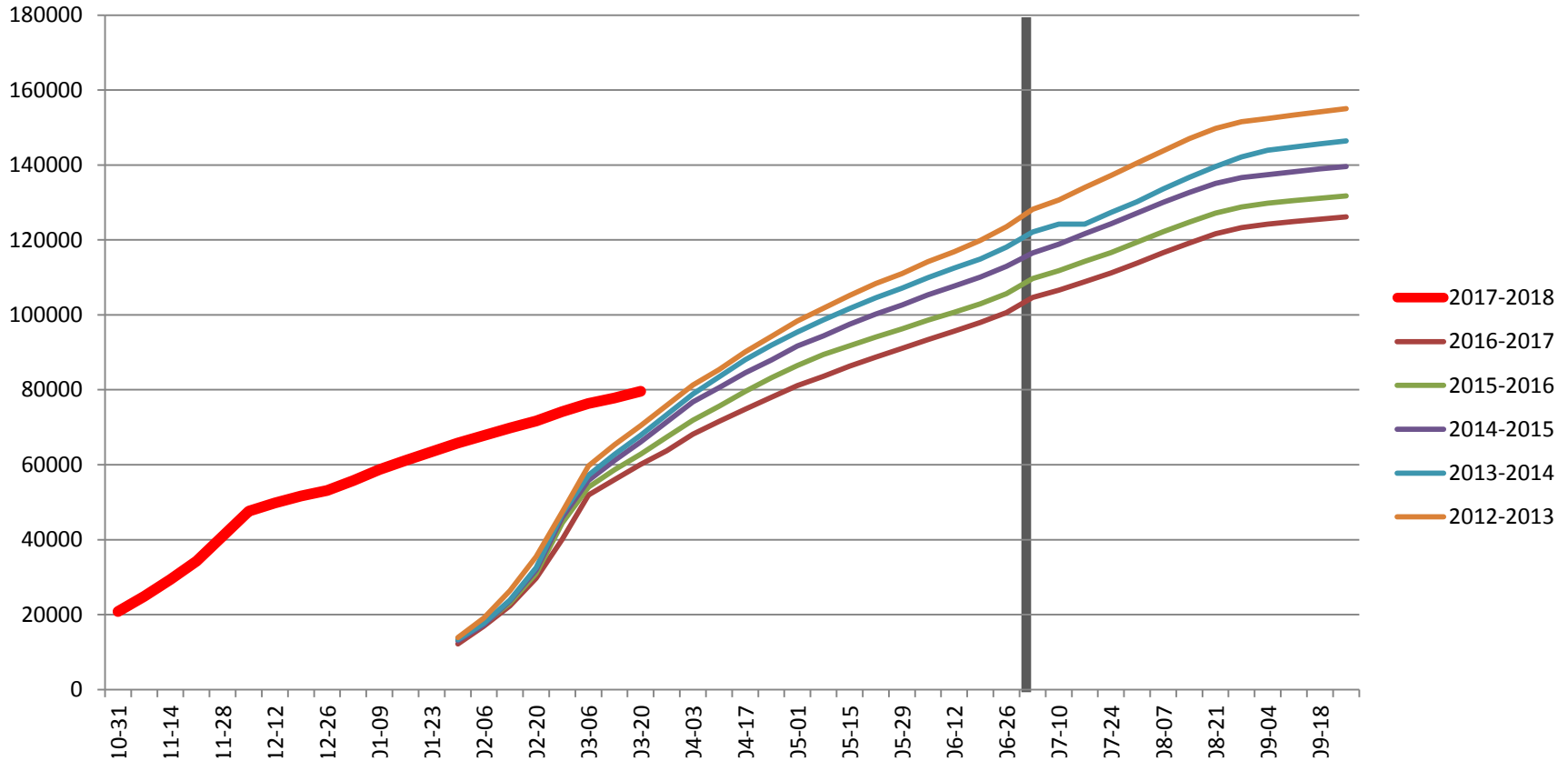

- Used to award state aid



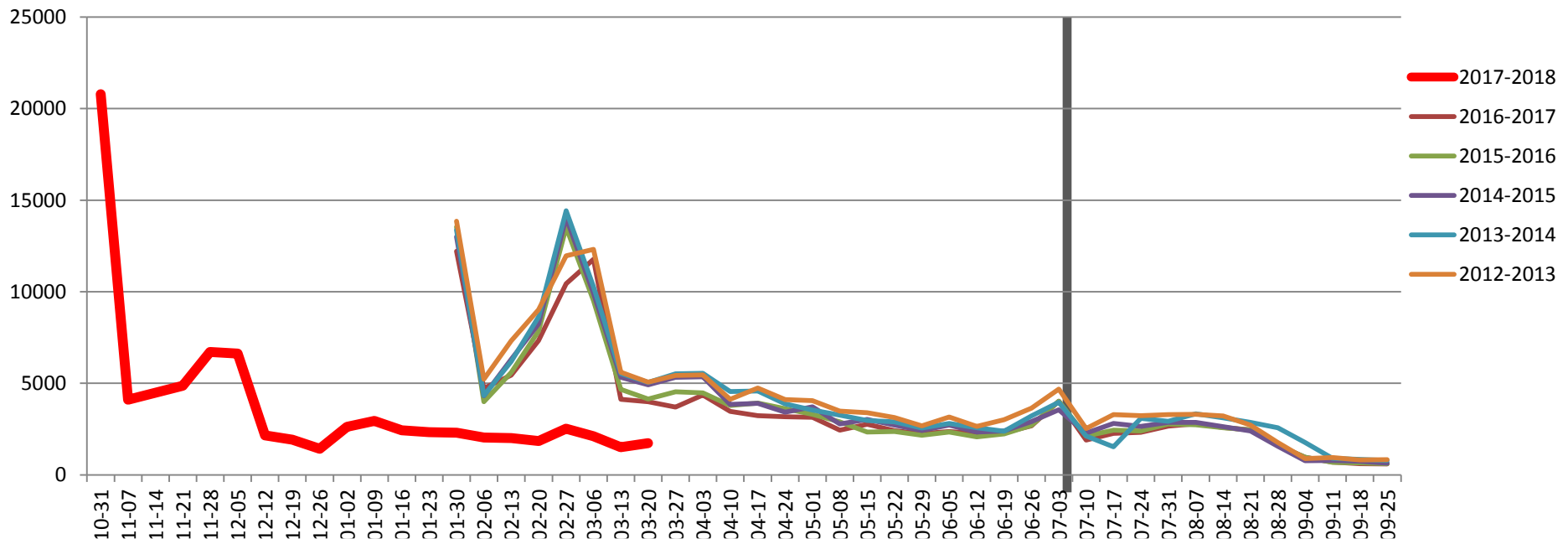
# Iowa FAFSA Trends



Total Iowa resident undergraduate FAFSA applications received by week (each week builds upon the next).



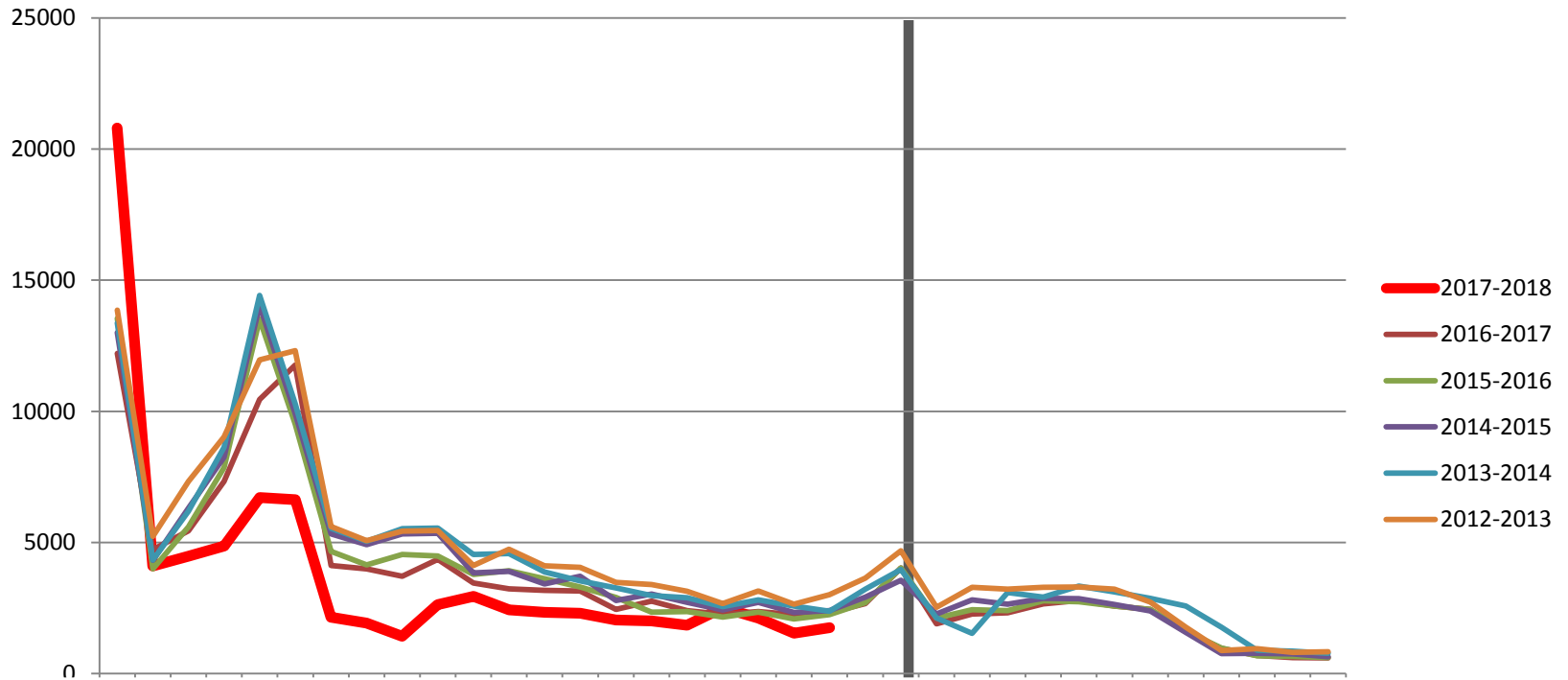

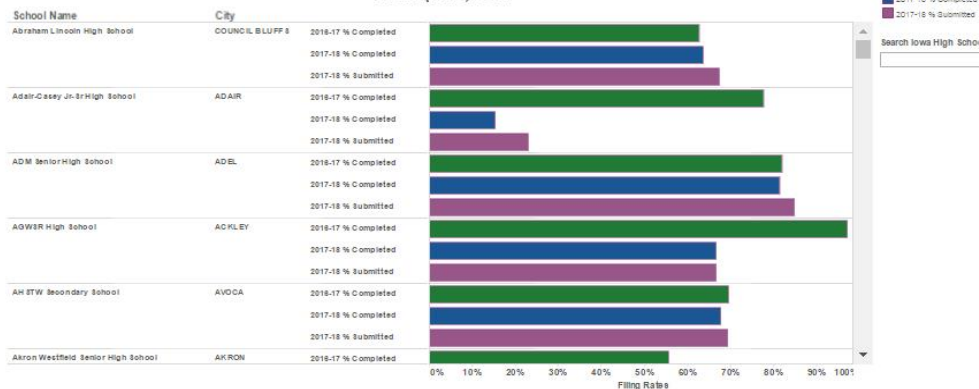

Fiscal Year 2017

- ✓ 1<sup>st</sup> Reduction -- \$390,984 – Primary Care
- ✓ 2<sup>nd</sup> Reduction -- \$115,194 – RN/PA

Fiscal Year 2018 – Governor’s Recommendation

- ✓ Reduce Primary Care -- \$84,514
- ✓ Administration -- \$2,617
